Detailed description of request

In anticipation of bidder queries relating to details of the planned Pre-Bid meeting and site visit described in ITB 7.4, we offer the following clarification of details.

Please confirm on or before the 7th of August :

- Your intention to attend this Pre-Bid meeting – yes, or no.
- If yes, numbers of personnel to attend pre-bid meeting in DGDC offices and numbers of personnel to attend site visits

As per ITB 7.4 (BDS) a Pre-Bid meeting shall commence on the following date, time and place:

- Date: 14th August 2019
- Time: 0900
- Place: DGDC, 18 Kennedy Road, Roseau, Dominica.

All bidders are encouraged to attend, but it is not mandatory.

The schedule is as follows:

14th August:

- Starting at 9am and until finished, presentations by DGDC and Jacobs Engineering (the Owner's Engineer)
- Following presentations, a site visit to the power plant site and the three wellpads will take place

15th August:

- Starting at 8am and lasting up to six hours, a site visit along most of the length of the reinjection pipeline route. This will include the cliff section and the suspension bridge site
- Following the above, a question and answer session will be held, location to be advised.

16th August:

- Held in reserve and/or if sufficient bidders have requests to revisit any of the sites, that may be organised (depending on numbers and available transport)

All sites are easily accessible apart from the reinjection pipeline route site; that visit will require an approximately 4-5 hrs (return) walk/hike along a cleared path in the jungle. A moderate level of fitness is needed, plus good hiking boots, protection from sun and equipment to carry water, food etc. Please ensure you come equipped with this, plus for all members whom wish to visit any of the sites a minimum level of PPE being: hi-vis vest and fully enclosed footwear. If you do not have this minimum PPE you will not be permitted on the sites. The DGDC will be providing transport to and from the sites.

If you need some advice on accommodation, we would recommend the Fort Young Hotel. Fort Young is about 10mins walk from the DGDC offices. If you find it is full, we can advise alternatives. Taxi drivers are generally available at the airport (Melville Hall) for transport from the airport to Roseau where the DGDC and Fort Young is located – they take XCD or USD. The trip takes about 1 hour.

Airlines that fly into Dominica are:

- Seaborne (usually from Puerto Rico)
- Liat (usually from Barbados)
- Winair/Air Antilles (usually from Sint Maarten)
- InterCaribbean (usually from British Virgin Islands)

General information about Dominica:

- Currency is Eastern Caribbean Dollar (XCD), though USD are often accepted
- 3G/4G cellphone service is generally good across the island. Local providers are Flow and Digicel. SIM cards for local service are available for either provider in Roseau.
- Electricity outlets are a mix of US and UK, though UK is the standard
